1 Introduction / Welcome

The world's ultimate desert rally, the Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge is set to return for its 32th edition in 2023 and is once again set to push participants to their physical and mental limits over some of the toughest yet most dramatic scenery the world has to offer. No other rally pits competitors against such demanding terrain – wave after wave of some of the world's most spectacular sand dunes – yet simultaneously takes in five-star luxury in the form of the stunning hotel that is located right in the middle of the Rhub al Khali (Empty Quarter) desert and acts as the race's base, and the dynamic, cutting-edge capital of the UAE, Abu Dhabi.

Now returning for its 32nd running for Auto's and 28th for Moto's, the Desert Challenge is once again being held across the emirate of Abu Dhabi, from the 25th February till 3rd March 2023, with spectators able to enjoy unrivalled access to the action in several breath-taking settings with dedicated, easy-to-access viewing points in the beautiful desert of the Western Region of Al Gharbia.

As in recent years, the race bivouac will again be located adjacent to the magnificent Qasr Al Sarab Desert Resort by Anantara. This venue provides a unique contrast between the harshness of endurance rallying and the supreme luxury of the amazing five-star resort, while simultaneously focusing the eyes of the world on Al Gharbia. This year's rally serves as a round of the FIM Cross-Country Rallies World Championship, and the FIA World Cup for Cross Country Rallies. Registration is open until the 18th of February 2023 to competitors driving cars and trucks complying with FIA T1, T2, T3, T4 and T5 technical regulations, and motorcycles and quads running under the auspices of the FIM.

The Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge is held under the patronage of H.H. Sheikh Hamdan Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, the Ruler's Representative in the Western Region, and organised by the EMSO with the backing of several major sponsors.

7 Sustainability Policy

EMSO is playing a leadership role in development of motorsport and encouraging motor sport stakeholders across UAE to incorporate best practices of sustainability framework by pursuing a holistic approach to environmental concerns. EMSO strives to adhere to the Best Practice Principles (BPP) framework of FIA by setting up core elements of its environmental impact and incorporating systematic approach to Environmental Management System (EMS).

EMSO commitment is defined as follows:

- 1. Collaboration with motor venues, organizers, sport clubs and competitors to promote and guide towards best environmental practices.
- 2. To collaborate with government entities and comply with legal requirements and legislation on national and international levels.
- 3. Encourage motor sport stakeholders across UAE to pursue sustainable actions for environment.
- 4. Support FIA Action for Environment and FIM Ride Green.
- 5. Demonstrate commitment to BPP by continuously improving on sustainability performance.
- 6. Continue to raise awareness of environmental concerns to senior management, staff and volunteers.
- 7. Minimize core elements of environmental impact by preserving water resources, implementing responsible waste management and energy saving systems.
- 8. Conduct an annual review of EMS to review environmental objectives and targets.

Purpose

EMSO recognises its vital role to play in delivering a better quality of life and environment for everyone in the UAE, both now and for future generations. We are committed to achieving continuous environmental improvement in all our activities and services. We will strive to reduce our own impact and make every effort to promote awareness of local and global issues that will facilitate sustainable development practices.

Principles

The EMSO will address the social, economic, and environmental considerations of sustainable development, defined as ensuring a better quality of life, according to the following principals:

- Social progress that recognises the needs of everyone,
- Effective protection of the environment
- Prudent use of natural resources.

Sustainable Communities

The EMSO is committed to contribute to sustainable community development where people are happy to live and work, meeting the diverse needs of the UAE residents. We contribute by engaging communities in motor sports, developing their skills, knowledge and confidence.

Sustainable development is about establishing social relationships of trust, of social capital, and is the core of active community participation and the key to a better quality of life. We operate a network of people with motorsport interests who have the desire to invest their time in running events in, and for, the UAE's benefit, who train other volunteers, and communicate and share their lives with others.

For sustainable development to be meaningful it must start with people making decisions about their lives, taking responsibility, giving back to the society and participating in the community, learning new skills, and recognising the consequences of actions.

We have identified the learning and skills development needs of UAE citizens, taking into account the unique demographic, economic and cultural factors of the country, and are implementing the plan to raise the level of involvement.

Resource Use

The EMSO will incorporate materials efficiency measure to reduce running costs. It will minimise resource consumption by:

- Reducing the amount of waste we produce by reducing our consumption and integrating effective methods of recycling,
- Promoting reuse, recycling and proper disposal of goods,
- Reviewing supplier products,
- Shifting towards electronic means of communication.
- Manage the use of energy, by shifting towards environmentally friendly products.

Transport

The EMSO is promoting public and shared transportation as the main means of travel to and from events to reduce traffic generation and its associated environmental impacts.

Application

EMSO Sustainability Statement is publicly endorsed and available on the website.

All staff, volunteers and other stakeholders have access to this policy and it should be referred to in decision-making and throughout team meetings.

Monitoring and Review

EMSO Sustainability Policy is reviewed on an annual basis by Sustainability Manager. Sustainability Manager works closely with the appointed Environmental Steward to make sure that all our daily and events-based actions are completely adhered to sustainable principles, listed in our statement.

Covid-19 Health Protocols & Guidelines entering Abu Dhabi

There are no longer any Covid-19 Travel restrictions into Abu Dhabi.

As of 26 February 2022, you no longer need a test before you fly to Abu Dhabi. Vaccinated and unvaccinated travellers are welcome to experience Abu Dhabi with no restrictions.







As of 7 November 2022, almost all Covid-19 restrictions in Abu Dhabi have been lifted meaning green status on the Al Hosn app and negative PCR tests are no longer required to enter Abu Dhabi attractions.

9 Entry Details - FIA World Championship event for Auto/Trucks

Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge Entry Incentive

To encourage greater women entries, it has been agreed that any single women motorcycle entry or Women driver and co-driver entry may be eligible for 15% off the published entry fee. This discount may not be combined with any other discount.

Dubai International Baja & Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge Incentive

To encourage greater entries at the two international events in the UAE, it has been agreed that any competitor participating in the two events in (2023 Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge and 2023 Dubai International Baja) will be entitled to a 50% discount on the entry fee for the Dubai International Baja event (service and media fees are not included).

This refund of 50% of the entry fee will only be refunded once the competitor has been confirmed to start both events. The refunds will be processed by the EMSO accordingly.

This discount is applied upon the competitor, not the vehicle. For example, a competitor who does each of the events in a different vehicle will be entitled to a discount, while one vehicle which is used by a different competitor on each event will not be entitled to a discount. Crews will be allowed to change co-drivers between events without it affecting their discounts.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE DISCOUNT DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY ADDITIONAL RELATED COSTS, I.E. INSURANCE, SERVICE CREW REGISTRATION, ETC.

To encourage greater women entries, it has been agreed that any single women motorcycle entry or Women driver and co-driver entry may be eligible for 15% off the published entry fee. This discount may not be combined with any other discount.

Dubai International Baja & Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge Incentive

To encourage greater entries at the two international events in the UAE, it has been agreed that any competitor participating in the two events in (2023 Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge and 2023 Dubai International Baja) will be entitled to a 50% discount on the entry fee for the Dubai International Baja event (service and media fees are not included).

This refund of 50% of the entry fee will only be refunded once the competitor has been confirmed to start both events. The refunds will be processed by the EMSO accordingly.

This discount is applied upon the competitor, not the vehicle. 13 Insurance

Civil Liability for Competitors

The entry fee includes cover for civil liability of the competitor from the Start of Documentation until retirement/exclusion, the limit for protests and appeals, post event Scrutineering.

Only Competitive vehicles (non GCC) are covered for Civil Liability towards Third Parties (Road Legal), from 23rd February – March 5th, 2023.

This cover provides for a maximum liability, in respect of any one claim or series of claims resulting from one accident, of AED 38,888,000 (USD 10,581,800. Damages to rally and/or service cars as well as the liability of a crew member towards other crew members are not covered by the insurance provided by the organizers.

Civil Liability for Service Vehicles

Pertinent Insurance Related Requirements

Competitors are reminded that Service Vehicles that are overseas are not insured in the UAE. The Organiser is able to ensure such vehicles for the duration of the event, provided that said vehicle/are registered with the organisation utilising the official event SERVICE VEHICLE REGISTRATION FORM and notably, also submitting a clearly scanned colour copy of the vehicle registration certificate (all pages/both sides). All documents will be verified at Administrative Checks. Competitors are furthermore reminded that UAE Rental Vehicles and all insurance related obligations are the sole responsibility of the competitor.

At the organizers discretion, a separate fee may be charged for each Service vehicle that would require insurance in the thirty days leading up to Documentation.

Repatriation and Medical Insurance

An accident & Sickness Emergency Medical and Repatriation expense is included in the entry fee to a level of AED 90,000 in excess of AED 15,000.

The repatriation insurance for the Service Crews is not included in the entry fees. It is each person's responsibility to purchase insurance.

UAE Rules concerning medical expenses and hospitalization

It is important for all Competitors to fully understand the situation with regards Medical expenses according to the UAE Rules.

In the event that "you" the registered Competitor has an accident during the event and requires medical attention in a hospital then the following procedure needs to be followed:

• On release from Hospital any Medical costs needs to be settled by you or third party before leaving the hospital.

In case of accident, a claim form will be sent to you or third party by email, which needs to be completed along with the Hospital report and receipt.

Once received and verified, then these documents are forwarded onto our Insurance Company for review and process.

Please note than there is an excess applicable to all insurance claims.

By the fact to sign your entry form, you fully understand the above, and the medical costs must be settled before leaving the hospital.

Tracking

The ADDC will use a new supplier Marlink for the tracking system. If you are not familiar with their Iritrack system, it is advised that you visit their resource page below on the Marlink website and or contact them below with any question. Additional information will be provided at the competitors briefing and in the supplementary regulations in regards to the operation of the Iritrack system or can be found in the 2023 FIA Cross Country Rally Sporting Regulations, Appendix V1, Section 12.1.1.

The rental cost of the Tracking/Safety system (Iritrack V3) and Timing system has been integrated into the Entry Fee. However, for Iritrack V3 you will require to purchase a mounting kit with one of two options below.

- Purchase a complete mounting kit online (Power cable, bracket, antennas) from the Marlink Eshop. Shipping is possible to the UAE in approximately 3-4 days.
- Purchase the complete mounting kit at the administrative checks. In case you choose this method, please be aware that you may have little time to set it up before your allotted time for scrutineering.

Installation of the mounting kit, your vehicle must be fully equipped with the iritrack kit at the technical checks and ready to plug the Iritrack in. You can find more information and mandatory instructions in the mounting guides provided on the Marlink website mentioned above.

Deposit

Competitors will be required to lodge a deposit of €1500 at event registration to Marlink directly; afore-mentioned deposit will be reimbursed upon the safe return of the Tracking and Timing Equipment in the Documentation room.

compliance of these GCAA regulations regarding the approved use of drones. They risk their accreditation being confiscated and access to the event revoked.

Time Zone

Abu Dhabi is falls within Gulf Standard Time (GST), which is UTC/GMT +4 hours.

UAE Visit Visas

If you are a national citizen of a GCC country you do not require a visa to visit the UAE. You will simply need to produce your GCC country passport or ID card upon arrival at the point of entry into the UAE.

Please visit the UAE Government website HERE to check if your country is eligible for a free visa on arrival.

Currencies

The local Currency is UAE Dirham (AED) = 100 fils.

The Dirham is tied to the US Dollar.

Most hotels will handle the exchange of foreign currency.

Exchange rate indications at the date of publishing:

- USD 1.00 = 3.67 AED
- EUR 1.00 = 3.99AED
- GBP 1.00 = 4.56 AED

These rates are accurate as of 21st January 2023

The import and export of both local and foreign currency are unrestricted. Amounts over AED 40,000 must be declared with the Customs.

Credit & debit cards: American Express, Diners Club, MasterCard and Visa are widely accepted.

Traveler's checks: are widely accepted. To avoid additional exchange rate charges, travelers are advised to take traveler's checks in US Dollars or Pounds Sterling.

Banking hours: Sat-Wed 0800-1300, Thurs 0800-1200. Some also open Sat-Wed 1630-1800.

Water

The tap water is heavily purified and safe to drink, but we would recommend the locally bottled mineral water (e.g. Al Ain Water).

Electricity

The electricity supply is 220/240 volts and 50 cycles; the socket type is the same as the three pin British system; most hotels have adapters for electrical appliances.

Fuel

- Diesel and gasoline are allowed. Bio-diesel and AVGAS may be used during the event but is not supplied by the organization.
- Petrol stations in the UAE are numerous and run by ADNOC in Abu Dhabi.







- Most offer extra services, such as car wash, oil change. Almost all of them have small supermarkets.
- The majority of visitors will find petrol far cheaper than in their home countries, prices range from E-Plus 91 2.59 AED, Special 95 2.67 AED, Super 98 2.78 AED, and Diesel 3.29 AED. The price for a litre of diesel fuel is now 3.29 AED. Only vehicles with valid door plates will be permitted access to the fueling tanker in the bivouac.
- Note: it is not ok to fill any jerry cans or containers.

Transportation

You can enter the Bivouac with a regular car, although 4x4 vehicles would be required for driving in the dunes. The organizers insist that only experienced desert drivers take vehicles off road. Only vehicles with valid door plates from the event will be permitted in the bivouac.

Telecommunications

- There are two telecommunication services providers in the UAE: Etisalat & Du.
- The telecommunication tariffs are reasonably competitive.
- The international dialing code of the UAE is +971.

Driving Rules

To drive in the UAE, you must hold an International Driving Permit and a driving license issued in your country of residence, or a driving license issued by a GCC country. Those on a non-UAE driving license are not permitted to drive privately owned vehicles in the UAE, only rental vehicles (competitive vehicles exempt).

In the UAE you drive on the right-hand side of the road. It is mandatory to wear seatbelts.

Most of the roads are monitored by both fixed and movable radars. Speed limits are usually 60-80 km around town and 100-120 km on the freeways. The speeding fines vary depending on the excess speed level.

The Traffic Police exercise a zero tolerance on drinking and driving!

If you are involved in a traffic accident, however minor, your car MUST in position and you MUST stay with it while awaiting the Traffic Police (by calling 999). All insurance claims require a police report to be processed.

Abui Dhabi Toll Roads

In Abu Dhabi there is a toll system in place called DARB. All cars transiting through these tolls during certain hours need to be aware that they may need pay the toll after passing them. You can find more information when the tolls are active and their locations on the DARB Toll System website <u>HERE</u>.

Important notes:

- Registered competitor vehicles will be exempt from these tolls.
- Teams renting cars should ask the rental car company if the car has been registered already for DARB Toll System.
- Vehicles that are provided to event officials will be covered by the organizer.
- Event registered service crew, media or any other official using their own vehicle not provided by the organizer will need to ensure they pay all tolls if their vehicle is not already registered through the DARB system.

The following items may be imported into the United Arab Emirates without incurring customs duty:

2000 cigarettes and 400 cigars and 2kg of tobacco; 2l of spirits of more than 22 per cent alcohol, and 2l of wine (non-Muslims over 18 years only); a reasonable amount of perfume for personal use.

Prohibited items: firearms and dangerous weapons, drugs, religious propaganda, pornographic materials, unstrung pearls except for personal use, raw seafood (only when visiting Dubai and/or Sharjah), fruit and vegetables from cholera-infected areas, a number of medications (if you are on a medication please, check whether it is allowed in the UAE before you leave).

Healthcare and Medical facilities

The general standard of healthcare in the UAE is high, both in the public and private sectors, although private hospitals have some distinct advantages (predominantly English-speaking, less waiting time, less cultural restrictions).

Medical facilities are of a very high quality but are extremely expensive. Private health insurance is essential, and highly recommended.

Pharmacies are open Saturday-Thursday from 0830-13:30 and 1630-2230, Fridays 1630-2230. Quite a few are open 24 hours.

Photography

Normal tourist photography is acceptable, but it is courteous to ask permission before photographing people. Do not take photos of the Arabic women if you do not have their permission.

In general, photographs of government buildings, military installations, ports and airports should not be taken.

Vehicle spares and services and franchises

We recommend to use the services and to buy the spares from the official car dealers of the UAE.






