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# Introduction

The Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge is one of the world's oldest and most prestigious international cross-country rallies. The event was founded in 1991 by Emirati motorsport legend and current FIA President Mohammed Ben Sulayem, and is organized by the Emirates Motorsports Organization (EMSO).

The event rapidly gained global fame with all the biggest names in international motorsport attempting to conquer the dunes of the UAE's unforgiving Rub'Al Khali Desert, the world's largest sand ocean.

33 years in, and thanks to the patronage of Abu Dhabi's Government through the strategic partnership with the Abu Dhabi Sports Council and energy partner ADNOC Distribution, the Abu Dhabi Desert Challenge has earned the reputation of being an event run to the highest safety and organizational standards, where participants can benefit from Abu Dhabi's world-class infrastructure. Today, the Desert Challenge is considered by competitors to be the most technical race on the calendar.

Celebrating its 34<sup>th</sup> edition the event returns with an emphasis on sustainability, and with added racing thrills, 2025 will see the introduction of a second rally bivouac and the action reaching new areas of the Al Dhafra region, after a successful introduction last year.

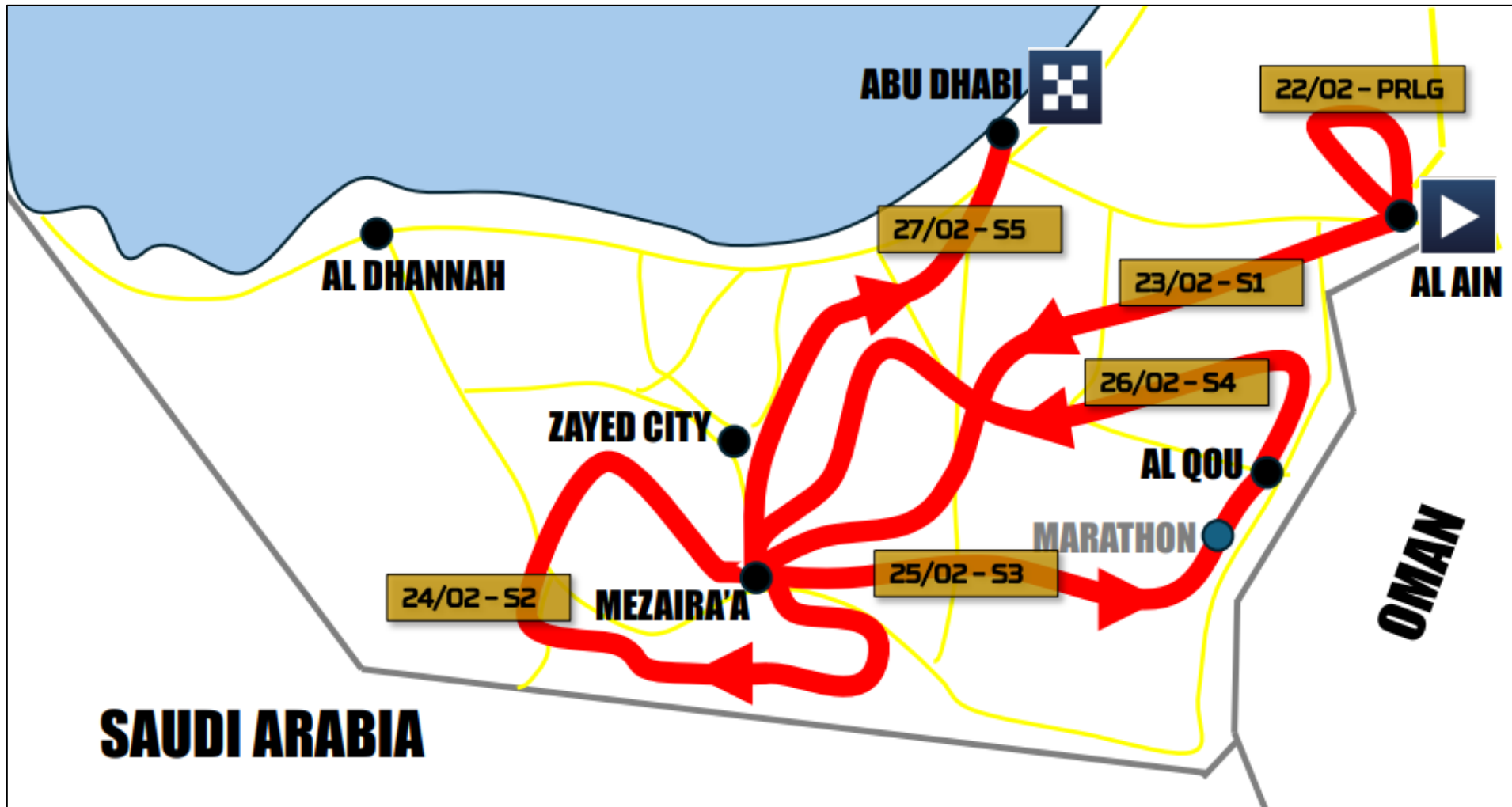

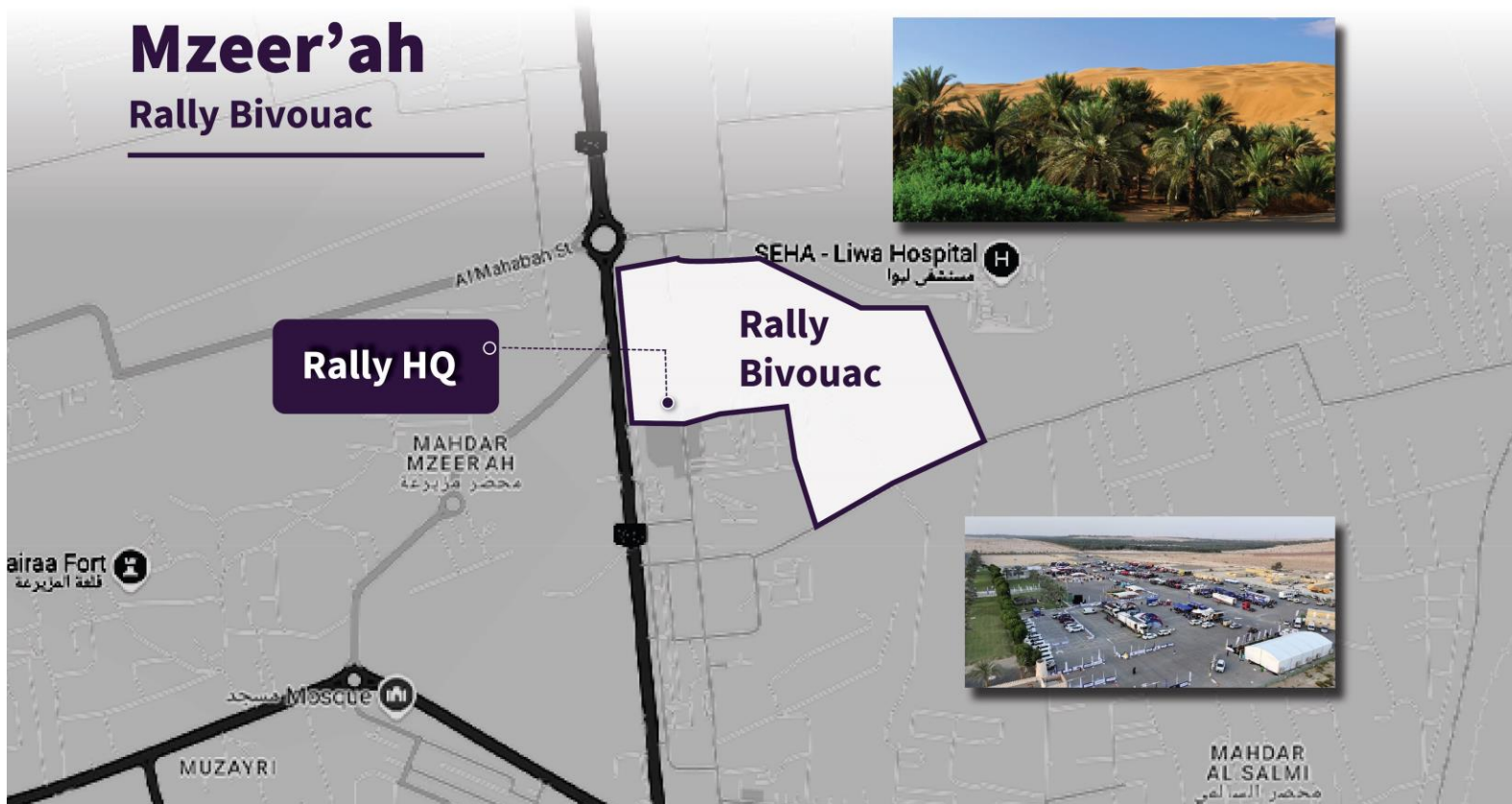

# Entry Fees

## THE REGISTRATION FEE INCLUDES:

- Meals (From February 21 (dinner) to 27 (lunch
- Fuel in the Bivouac (Feb 22-27th) for all race and service vehicles. Only the vehicles with rally plate stickers are allowed,
- Fuel at remote refueling on stages requiring so, for bikes, quads, Challenger and SSV,
- Competitors' sporting rights,
- Participation in the event (administrative and scrutineering, prologue and 5 days of racing) with sport organization, logistics and organization documents,
- Competitors' visa (if not delivered at airport) registered before the earlier bird rate cutoff date.
- Organizer's Public liability insurance,
- Medical and repatriation insurance for competitors and overseas assistance personnel registered with the event,
- Licensed Medical staff,
- Medical resources: Ambulances and medical helicopters, all equipped with first aid and rescue equipment on stages
- Medical Center at the Bivouac,
- At the bivouac, access to the camping area with bathrooms and showers,
- Provision of energy, water and security for motorhomes and camping cars,
- **For MALLE MOTO category:** Round trip transport from service park to service park for competitors box, spare tires/wheels and camping equipment.
- Awards ceremony and dinner.

## REGISTRATION FEES DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- Rental of safety equipment (MARLINK). Deposit €1,500 due at documentation.
- Rental of navigation equipment Electronic road book and their equipment (ERTF). Deposit €1,700 due at documentation.
- Round trip transport of any competitor, flight, vehicles or equipment (except malle moto).
- Supplementary insurance
- The compulsory Sport license required to compete.
- Hotel Accommodation
- Visa for service crews

## FIA World Championship Registration

In order to score points in the Manufacturers, Drivers and Codrivers Championships, competitors must have pre-registered with the FIA before 13 December 2024. After this date, registration for the Drivers and Codrivers Championships is permitted until the closing date for entries for the first Event for which the competitor wishes to score points. Registrations must be made using the entry form which can be found on the FIA website at: <https://registrations.fia.com/w2rc>

In order to participate in the event, the rider must hold a valid FIM competitor's licence for the event: Annual or One Event (Article 70.2.1 of the FIM Sporting Code)

New for this year, all FIM competitors will automatically be entered into the W2RC and éligible to score points in the World Championship as the fee is now included in the event entry fee.

## FIM Rules

### FIM World Rally Raid Championship Event For Moto And Quad

The **FIM World Rally-Raid Championship** is under the joint management of the FIM and its contracted promoter (ASO). As such a joint committee is formed: The Championship Committee. The FIM World Rally Raid Championship and FIM Prize Events are held each year and include the following title/category:

#### Category RallyGP – FIM World Rally-Raid Championship

- Group 1: Moto – Rally (Up to 450cc)
- Rider: Experienced competitors only. A list of eligible riders will be published by FIM website.
- 2025 FIM Licence reference / article: 62 801 01 ANNUAL or 62 801 11 ONE EVENT

#### Category Rally2 – FIM World Rally-Raid Cups

- Group 1: Moto-Rally (Up to 450cc)
- Rider: open to all except rider registered on RallyGP list
- 2025 FIM Licence reference / article 62 801 02 ANNUAL or 62 801 12 ONE EVENT

#### Category Quad - FIM World Rally-Raid Cups

- Quad according to the FIM Technical rules. Maximum speed 130 km/h
- Rider : Open to all
- 2025 FIM Licence reference / article 62 801 02 ANNUAL or 62 801 12 ONE EVENT



# Malle Moto

**MALLE MOTO** is open to all Bike and Quad Amateur riders who do not benefit from the assistance of an accompanying person registered in the race or in Service category, or in Media and more generally of any accredited person (Organisation, bracelets for guests, etc.). Any infringement will result in Disqualification of the Rider from this category.

EMSO will arrange the following items for the Competitors registered in MALLE MOTO:

- basic tent
- sleeping mattress
- sleeping bag
- 80L box to load their equipment into
- Environmental mat.

## WORKING AREA

Shared resources for the malle moto group will include working area with pop-up tents, tables, access to electricity and some basic hand tools. Note these resources will not be available at the marathon camp.

## LOGISTIC

All logistics from start in Al Ain to finish of the rally in Abu Dhabi . This may include all the above equipment plus for each person, an additional personal luggage bag (Max 100L), 3 spare tyres, 2 spare wheels and bike work stand.

The Rider's race number must be marked on the hubs of each wheel and visibly marked on each tyre.

All equipment transported by the Organisation must be handed over before the start of the Race at the EMSO Logistics Compound (Exact place and times will be communicated later).



# Malle Moto

## Rules

### TIME CARD MANAGEMENT

At the finish of a Stage, the Rider will give his Time Card to the Chief Marshal of the TC End of Stage, at the bivouac entrance; the Marshal writes their time of arrival and gives the Rider their time card back; the Rider goes straight to the “MALLE MOTO Bivouac” area and gives his Time Card to the person in charge of the area. A maximum time of 10 minutes must be respected.

At the Bivouac, it is mandatory for the Rider registered in “MALLE MOTO” to set-up and make all/any service and repairs and sleep in the dedicated area, **located close to the catering tent**. This implies compliance with the following rules.

Only the Rider is allowed to:

- transport his tyres and wheels to the BF Goodrich area;
- work on his Machine or on a damaged part;
- set up and dismantle his tent.

Riders of the "MALLE MOTO" Challenge must not receive any outside help. Only Service between Riders of the "MALLE MOTO" , still in the race, or by the Organisation's staff dedicated to this category will be authorised.

Any other Service will be sanctioned, the penalty may go as far as the disqualification of the Rider from the category.

Riders may take their Machine or a damaged part out of the “MALLE MOTO” area only after having informed the person in charge of the area. Riders must be accompanied by a member of the Organisation, from the “MALLE MOTO” team, to carry out certain exceptional operations:

- Any repairs requiring specific equipment not available in the “MALLE MOTO” area, after agreement from the technical commissioner (welding, machining, suspension repairs, etc.).

# Malle Moto

## Rules (continued)

These repairs must be carried out by Riders themselves under the supervision of a member of the Organisation accompanying him;

- Carry out tests;
- Refuel their Machines;
- Clean their Machines.

In case of litigation, the area manager will make a written statement to the Officials with the time of absence and the reasons.

If it appears that the type of operation does not comply with this article and/or that the spirit of the category is not respected, the Rider shall be excluded from the Challenge and may therefore no longer benefit from the related services.

In the event of withdrawal, the Rider:

- will continue to have access to his personal belongings and to sleep in the “MALLE MOTO” area;
- may in no case provide any form of Service to the remaining “MALLE MOTO” Riders still in the race.



# Service Crew/Vehicle Entry Fees

All Competitors, Service Crews, Media, Officials and Organization personnel will all be identified with coloured wristbands that they will receive at Documentation.

Entry fees valid to 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2025 needs to be paid before 21/02/2025. Payments done at Documentation will be increase of 10%.

All entries MUST be submitted to [entry@emso.ae](mailto:entry@emso.ae) and a copy of the bank transfer needs to be attached.

A copy of each passport needs to be sent with the Service Crews form and the copy of the driving licence of the crews allowed to drive the vehicle.

**According to the FIA and FIM regulations the registration of the Services Crews and Service Vehicle is COMPULSORY.**

**Please note that the EMSO will no longer organize UAE visas for Service Crews.**

Instead an 'Participation Letter' can be prepared upon request by email to [entry@emso.ae](mailto:entry@emso.ae) only if the entry is paid.

Please note that this letter will not cover any expenses during the stay in UAE in case of accident, hospitalization and / or repatriation.

Each Service Crew member needs to have their own travel insurance during his stay in UAE. This letter cannot be used for Customs Formalities (Temporary Importation).

The rental cost of the Tracking/Safety system (Iritrack V3) and Timing system is NOT included in the Entry Fee.

For Iritrack V3 you will require to purchase a mounting kit with one of two options below if you have not used it before and already own the required mounting kit.

- Purchase a complete mounting kit online (Power cable, bracket, antennas) from the Marlink Eshop.

Shipping is possible to the UAE in approximately 3-4 days.

- Purchase the complete mounting kit at the administrative checks. In case you choose this method, please be aware that you may have little time to set it up before your allotted time for scrutineering.

Installation of the mounting kit, your vehicle must be fully equipped with the iritrack kit at the technical checks and ready to plug the Iritrack in. You can find more information and mandatory instructions in the mounting guides provided on the Marlink website mentioned above.

## Deposit

Competitors will be required to lodge a **deposit of €1500** at event registration to Marlink directly; afore-mentioned deposit will be reimbursed upon the safe return of the Tracking and Timing Equipment in the Documentation room.

# Navigation Equipment

## Navigation and Safety equipment

The ADDC will continue working with **ERTF** to provide navigation and sentinel for competitors.

The cost of these devices is **NOT** included in the Entry Fee and must be paid directly to ERTF. ERTF will request a **deposit of €1700** for the material.

The electronic road book will be used for this rally for both FIA Auto and all FIM competitors.

# Insurance (medical)

## Repatriation and Medical Insurance

An accident & Sickness Emergency Medical and Repatriation expense is included in the entry fee to a level of AED 626,000 (\$170,000 / EUR 159,000).

The repatriation insurance for the Service Crews is not included in the entry fees. It is each team or service crew member's responsibility to purchase the service crew package to ensure they have insurance coverage.

## UAE Rules concerning medical expenses and hospitalization

It is important for all Competitors to fully understand the situation with regards to Medical expenses according to the UAE Rules.

In the event that "you" the registered Competitor has an accident during the event and requires medical attention in a hospital then the following procedure needs to be followed:

- On release from Hospital any Medical costs needs to be settled by you or third party before leaving the hospital.

In case of accident, a claim form will be sent to you or third party by email, which needs to be completed along with the Hospital report and receipt.

Once received and verified, then these documents are forwarded onto our Insurance Company for review and process.

Please note than there is an excess applicable to all insurance claims.

By the fact to sign your entry form, you fully understand the above, and the medical costs must be settled before leaving the hospital.



# Insurance (civil liability)

## Civil Liability for Competitors and Service Crews

The entry fee includes cover for civil liability of the competitor from the Start of Documentation until retirement/ exclusion, the limit for protests and appeals, post event Scrutineering, **so from 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> of February, 2025.**

This cover provides for a maximum liability, in respect of any one claim or series of claims resulting from one accident, of AED 38,888,000 (USD 10,581,800. Damages to rally and/or service cars as well as the liability of a crew member towards other crew members are not covered by the insurance provided by the organizers.

## Civil Liability for Service Vehicles

**Only Overseas Competitive vehicles (non GCC) are covered for Civil Liability towards Third Parties (Road Legal), from 19<sup>th</sup> February to March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Outside of these dates, the owner of the vehicles needs to have his proper insurance valid in UAE.**

Pertinent Insurance Related Requirements:

The Organiser is able to ensure such vehicles for the duration of the event, provided that said vehicle/are registered with the organisation utilising the official event SERVICE VEHICLE REGISTRATION FORM and also submitting a clearly scanned colour copy of the vehicle registration certificate (all pages/both sides) and temporary import documents. Competitors are furthermore reminded that UAE Rental Vehicles and all insurance related obligations are the sole responsibility of the competitor.





# Accommodation

## Temporary Import/Duty Free Solutions into UAE

### ATA Carnet

UAE customs accepts ATA Carnet to facilitate duty free temporary import. ATA Carnet could be obtained through the authorized chamber of commerce in your country. Please ensure no consumable items such as spare parts, oils and merchandise (if any) are mentioned on ATA Carnet.

### Temporary Import Deposit

UAE customs allows temporary import against 'temporary import duty deposit' which is 5% of your shipment value. Our logistics partner DHL Logistics would facilitate temporary import deposit upon arrival of shipment at UAE port/airport. Items can be listed on shipping commercial invoice and packing list and sent to us at [logistics@emso.ae](mailto:logistics@emso.ae)

**Note: All spare parts and oils are entitled to duty + VAT and will not be treated as temporary import. Present customs regulation apply customs duty at 5% of CIF value or customs assessed value + VAT 5% of duty +CIF value.**
